Lesson 1: The Open Strings


Using an electronic tuner, pitch pipe, or piano as a reference, tune your open strings to the notes **g**, **c**, **e**, and **a**.




Pick each note (they're all open strings). Use the pad of your right thumb.



Lesson 2: The C Scale



Play the C scale forward and backward. To start, pick each note eight times. Then gradually decrease the number of times you pick each note until you can play it as written. Keep it steady!



Ready for a challenge? Here's another way to practise the C scale:




Keep your left thumb **behind the neck** of your uke to support your fingers.


Press until you get a clean, clear sound.
